

Supply List



Bring-your-own serger (required)

- BERNINA L 890 or QE 890 – *this class will only be using the 890 serger*
- Power cord, foot control, owner's manual
- Feet: **C11** (standard overlock/combination) and **C13** (cover/chainstitch)
- Tools: screwdriver, tweezers, lint brush, small oiler, coverstitch insert, knife cover insert, cut off bin, side table, needle threader spool net, threading wire, CS Lock tool,
- Needles
 - 1 pk of Coverstitch – ELX705 80/12
 - 1 pk of Overlock – Elx705 90/14
- Optional but **highly recommended**: The Big Book of Serging A Guide to Overlock Machines

Pattern

Download the free **Banner** template from **WeAllSew.com**. Print it at **100% (no scaling)** and bring the **uncut pages** to class—we'll resize and trim them together during the lesson.

Thread

- **5 Cones** – Yellow, Green, Blue, Red, and Purple – Optional: Hinkletown sells a smaller cone kit if you don't already have these colors in your stock
 - **Please be sure to bring this to class.** If you don't you may be confused when looking over your examples later.
- **1–4 additional cones/spools** to cover chain/coverstitch needles + chain looper (match or contrast as you like)
- Wonderfil Glamour 12 wt thread
- Wonderfil 12wt Fruitti – This is a variegated thread
- Optional: Maxi Lock Stretch for **upper looper** during rolled hem demo
 - I used the 5-cone kit – (4) tan Seracor cones – (1) Wonderfil Blue 12 wt thread – (1) Blue Maxi-Lock Stretch (1) Wonderfil 12wt Green Fruitti

Fabric (seven triangle pennants + extras)

- If using the same color fabric, you will need approximately 3 ½ yards
- If you use scraps please follow the following guidelines
 - Fronts
 - (7) 14" x 14" We will cut them down after stitching
 - Backs
 - (pattern cut size): 7 pieces at 7" top x 9" height (We will cut this out in class)
 - Please do not cut before class as your pendants may be a little bigger or smaller than mine finished at
 - Prairie points: 2" cut from WOF
 - Ruffle strip: 5 pieces at 1.5" x WOF
 - Bias Binding: 2 ½" x 126" This is an approximate width. It is personal preference for tying the ends
 - Surging practice: (20) scrap 10" x 10" squares

Fabric preparation

Supply List

Please have all fabric cut to size before coming to class.

- Cut out your 14" x 14" pendant fronts
- Cut out your 2 x WOF prairie point pieces
- Cut out your (5) 1.5" x WOF ruffle strips
- Cut and prepare your bias binding
- Cut out your practice pieces at 10" x 10"
 - Optional: 2–3 yards of ½" cotton twill tape or double-fold bias tape to string the pennants in place of preparing the bias binding

Workspace & comfort

- Optional small cutting mat and rotary cutter for trimming – some are provided in classroom
- Labeled zip bags, trays, or paper plates to keep each pennant's pieces together
- Sticky Notes to label pendants
