

**Elizabeth Hartman's Show & Tell Quilt
Student Supply List**

Pattern:

Show and Tell quilt pattern by Elizabeth Hartman

Basic Sewing Kit:

- Fabric shears
- Patchwork pins
- Thread snips
- Seam ripper
- Machine piecing thread in a neutral color to match your fabrics

Additional Supplies:

- Frixion pen or fine tip fabric marking pencil and small ruler for drawing diagonal lines on your fabric squares, OR
- Cluck Cluck Sew Diagonal Seam Tape
- 15" Mini Design Boards to organize your blocks
- Alphabet pins for labeling your pieces. You can also make your own version of alphabet pins using flat flowerhead pins (or any pin with a flat head big enough to write on) and a fine point sharpie.

Rotary Cutting Supplies:

- Rotary cutter with fresh blade
- Acrylic rulers: I like the following sizes:
 - 6" x 24"
 - 4" x 14"
- Cutting mat: 18" x 24" is a good size

Optional Supplies:

- Iron and pressing mat for your workstation
- Your favorite spray starch

Sewing Machine, etc:

- Sewing machine in working order
- 1/4" patchwork foot
- Sewing machine needles

Fabric:

- See pattern for yardage amounts

Clearly this will be a marathon project, so no need to cut out the entire quilt prior to class.
☺ You can start with a block or two. Or, you can simply make a mini quilt using just one block!

It's usually recommended to pre-starch your fabrics before cutting when piecing small pieces as in this pattern. We'll discuss that in class, but to do so, simply saturate your fabric with spray starch (grocery store brands such as Niagara or Faultless) and allow to dry (you can lay the fabric flat or hang over a drying rack to dry) before ironing and cutting.
